# RAGLANSWEATER

Design: Lene Holme Samsøe • No. 2161BC

Size	XS/S	S/M	M/L	L	XL
<b>Bust</b>	81	89	95	101	107 cm
<b>Length</b>	54	56	58	60	62 cm
<b>Yarn</b>	300	350	350	400	450 g <b>ALBA</b> from <b>BC Garn</b>

**Needles** 2½ and 3 mm set of double pointed needles, 2½ and 3 mm circular needles  
40, 60 and 80 cm long

**Tension** 26 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3 mm needles

The sweater is worked in the round from the neck downwards. Change between double pointed needles and longer/shorter circular needles as needed.

Using 2½ mm circular needle cast on 128 (136) 142 (150) 154 sts. Knit 9 rounds (= st st rolled neck edge).

Change to 3 mm circular needle and continue as follows:  
K1, mark this st (= raglan st), P36 (40) 43 (46) 48 (= back), K1, mark this st (= raglan st), P(26) 26 (28) 28 (= right sleeve), K1, mark this st (= raglan st), P27 (31) 34 (37) 39, work following 9 sts according to large chart (the 3 leaves are worked from the smaller chart), K1, mark this st (= raglan st), P(26) 26 (28) 28 (= left sleeve).

Continue working sts as set, and at the same time increase 8 sts in every 2nd round by working a yarn over on either side of each raglan st. In following row, purl the yarn overs.

**Note!** After finishing the chart, turn work wrong side out and continue in the round from the wrong side, now knitting all sts.

Work raglan increases a total of 28 (30) 32 (34) 36 times = 352 (376) 398 (422) 442 sts in the round.

Now divide for sleeves and front/back by casting off all raglan sts and working each part separately.

## Back/front

Using 3 mm circular needle work sts for back and front, casting on 13 (15) 16 (17) 19 sts at each side over sleeve sts for armhole = 210 (232) 246 (262) 278 sts. Continue working in the round in st st from wrong side of work (= reverse st st on right side), marking the middle 1 (1) 2 (1) 1 side st(s) at each side for side "seam".

Continue straight until work measures 5 cm from cast on side sts.

Next round (= decrease round): \*K until 2 sts before marked side st(s), slip 1, K1, pass slipped st over, K marked st(s), K2 together, repeat from \*.

- = K from right side
- = K from left side
- ◼ = P from right side
- ◻ = Slip 1, K1, pass slipped st over
- ◀ = Slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K1, then P1 from cable needle
- ▶ = Slip next st onto cable needle and leave at front of work, P1, then K1 from cable needle

Work decrease round every 5 cm another 5 times = 186 (208) 222 (238) 254 sts.

Continue straight until work measures 53 (55) 57 (59) 61 cm from neck edge (or desired length). Turn work wrong side in, change to 2½ mm needles and knit 9 rounds (= st st rolled hem).

Cast off.

## Sleeves

Using short 3 mm circular needle cast on 9 (11) 12 (13) 15 sts at underarm and work sleeve sts = 91 (97) 102 (109) 115 sts. Mark the middle 1 (1) 2 (1) 1 underarm st(s) for sleeve "seam".

Continue working in the round in st st from wrong side of work until sleeve measures 3 (3) 2 (6) 1 cm from cast on sleeve sts.

In the following round decrease 1 st on either side of "seam" st(s), working decreases in the same way as for side seams.

Work decrease round every 5 (4) 4 (3) 3 cm another 6 (7) 8 (9) 11 times = 77 (81) 84 (89) 91 sts.

Continue straight until sleeve measures 35 cm from cast on sleeve sts (or desired length).

Turn work wrong side in, change to 2½ mm needles and knit 9 rounds (= st st rolled hem).

Cast off.

## Finishing

Sew underarm opening.

Rinse, spin lightly and leave flat to dry.
