Yoke:

The sweater is knit bottom down in the round.

On smaller needle with MC cast on 128 sts and working in ribbing (k1, p1).

When ribbing measures 2,5 cm, change to larger needle and on the following round, place markers after every 8 sts, 16 markers in total, while working in this manner: rnd. 1 & 2: MC: k all sts

rnd. 3: CC: k all sts

rnd. 4: CC: *k to marker, inc 1, repeat from * around repeat rnd. 1 - 4, 17 (19) 21 times in total (400 (432) 464 sts).

With MC, knit 2 rnds, while removing all the markers, except for the beginning of round marker.

Now raise back of neck using short rows;

k204 (220) 236, w&t, p292 (312) 334, w&t, continue in this manner w&t'ing 18 (19) 20 sts before the last w&t on the same side of work, until you have worked 16 rows of short rows and there are 40 (46) 54 sts between the last two turns.

Continue in stockinette stitch in the round and on the following rnd close gaps at turns, by knitting the wraps together with the neighbouring stitch

Work one more round. On the following round, divide work into body and sleeves, in this way:

k116 (128) 138 (= back), cast on 8 new sts, place the following 84 (88) 94 sts (= right sleeve) on a holder, k116 (128) 138 (= front), cast on 8 new sts, place the following 84 (88) 94 sts (= left sleeve) on a holder.

Body:

Continue working in stockinette stitch in the round with MC on the 248 (272) 292 sts of the body, until 10 rnds (on the front) from the last colour change. Change to CC and work 2 rnds of stockinette stitch. Continue in this manner down the front, by knitting alternately 10 rnds of MC and 2 rnds of CC. When your work measures 63 (64) 65 cm, while keeping pattern, change to smaller needle and work 3 cm of ribbing (k1, p1), ending with 2 rnds of MC. Bind off in ribbing with MC.

Sleeve:

Work the 84 (88) 94 sts from holder onto larger needle, and pick up and knit 8 sts from the ones you cast on under the arm, place a marker between the 4th and 5th stitch, which from here on marks beginning of round. Keeping pattern, so that it follows the pattern on the body, working alternately 10 rnds of MC and 2 rnds of CC. When the sleeve measures 7 (7,5) 8,5 cm from the parting, change to smaller needle and work 3 cm of ribbing (k1, p1), ending with 2 rnds of MC. Bind off in ribbing with MC.
