### ALBA from BC Garn

<b>Needles:</b>	3 and 3.5 mm straight needles. 1 dp needle 3.5 mm. (UK Size: 11 and 10/US Size: 2 and 4) Crochet hook 2.5 mm. (UK Size: 12/US Size: c/2)
<b>Tension:</b>	25 sts and 30 rows in st st on 3.5 needle = 10 x 10 cm
<b>Extra:</b>	4 buttons

### Crochet abbreviations (British terms):

Ch – chain  
Dc – double crochet

### Eyelet stripe pattern:

**Row 1 (col. 17 lime):** Knit.  
**Row 2 (col. 17 lime):** Knit.  
**Row 3 (col. 17 lime):** Purl  
**Row 4 (col. 17 lime):** Purl  
**Row 5 (col. 15 taube):** Knit  
**Row 6 (col. 15 taube):** Knit  
**Row 7 (col. 17 orange):** K1, \*k2tog, yo, repeat from \* to last st, K1.  
**Row 8 (col. 17 orange):** Purl  
**Row 9 (col. 15 taube):** Knit  
**Row 10 (col. 15 taube):** Knit

### Repeat these 10 rows for eyelet stripe pattern

#### Back:

Cast on 96 [102; 106] sts using 3.5 mm straight needle and col. 15 taube.

Work st st, first row is from WS. Work straight until back measures 21 [22; 23] cm.

#### Armhole shaping:

Cast off 4 [5; 5] sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Then 2 [2; 2] sts on foll 2 rows, and 1 [1; 1] st at beginning of foll 4 rows = 80 [84; 88] sts.

#### Work pleat as follows:

Next row (RS): K 28 [30; 32], slip next 6 sts to dp needle in front of work, hold dp needle parallel in front of left hand straight needle and knit sts in both layers together as follows: \*k1 from dp needle

without slipping st from needle, k1 from left hand straight needle, slip both sts, repeat from \* until all sts from dp needle are worked. Slip next 6 sts to dp needle at back of work, hold dp needle parallel behind left hand straight needle and repeat from \* until all sts from dp needle are worked. K 28 [30; 32] = 68 [72; 76] sts.

Next row: K to end using col. 15 taube.

Continue straight working eyelet stripe pattern as described above until back measures 33 [35; 37] cm.

#### Neck and shoulder:

Next row (RS): Cast off centre 26 [28; 28] sts, K to end.

Work each side separately.

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Work 1 row.

Next row: Cast off 1 st at neck side.

When back measures 35 [37; 40] cm, cast off rem sts.

### Left front:

Cast on 54 [56; 58] sts using 3.5 needle and col. 15 taube.

Work st st, first row is from WS. Work straight until left front measures 21 [22; 23] cm.\*\*

### Armhole and pleat:

Next row (RS): Cast off 4 [5; 5] sts for armhole, K 11 [11; 12], slip next 6 sts to dp needle in front of work, hold dp needle parallel in front of left hand straight needle and knit sts in both layers together as follows: \*k1 from dp needle without slipping st from needle, k1 from left hand straight needle, slip both sts, repeat from \* until all sts from dp needle are worked. Slip next 6 sts to dp needle in back of work, hold dp needle parallel behind left hand straight needle and repeat from \* until all sts from dp needle are worked, K 11 [12; 13].

Work 1 row.

Continue working armhole shaping as on back, at same time work eyelet stripe pattern as described above until left front measures 30 [31; 33] cm. End with WS facing for next row.

### Neck:

Next row (WS): Cast off 10 [10; 10] sts at beginning of row. Work according to eyelet stripe pattern to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off 3 sts at beginning of row. Work according to eyelet stripe pattern to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off 1 st at beginning of row. Work according to eyelet stripe pattern to end.

Continue straight to left front is same length as on back to shoulder cast off.

Cast off rem sts.

### Right front:

Work as on left front to \*\*. End with WS facing for next row.

Armhole

Next row (WS): Cast off 4 [5; 5] sts for armhole, continue according to eyelet pattern to end.

Next row: K 11 [12; 13], slip next 6 sts to dp needle in front of work, hold dp needle parallel in front of

left hand straight needle and knit sts in both layers together as follows: \*k1 from dp needle without slipping st from needle, k1 from left hand straight needle, slip both sts, repeat from \* until all sts from dp needle are worked. Slip next 6 sts to dp needle in back of work, hold dp needle parallel behind left hand straight needle and repeat from \* until all sts from dp needle are worked. K 11 [11; 12].

Continue working armhole shaping as on back, at same time when right front is 30 [31; 33] cm, work neck shaping as on left front, reversing shape. Cast off rem sts when right front is same length as on back at shoulder cast off.

### Sleeve:

Cast on 56 [60; 60] sts on 3 mm straight needles and col. 15 taube.

Row 1 (WS): \*P2, K2, repeat from \* to end. Work rib as established on first row until rib is 5 [6; 7] cm.

Change to 3.5 mm needle and work st st until sleeve is 10 [11; 12] cm.

Next row (RS): Increase 1 st each end of row.

Repeat increases on every 8th row to 70 [74; 76] sts.

Continue straight until sleeve is 31 [35; 38] cm.

### Top:

Cast off 4 [5; 5] sts at beginning of next 2 rows, then 2 [2; 2] sts at beginning of next 8 rows, then 1 [1; 1] st on foll 8 rows, then 2 [2; 2] sts on foll 4 rows, then 3 [3; 3] sts on foll 4 rows.

Cast off rem sts.

### Making up:

Weave in all ends. Join shoulder seams using mattress sts. Sew in sleeve and join sleeve and side seams.

### Neck and front border:

Join col 15 taube at right front cast on edge. Using crochet hook 2.5 mm work dc along right front row ends, neck and left front row ends. Work 2 dcs for every 3 row and 1 dc into every cast off st. Work 3 dcs into each corner. Turn and work 1 dc into each dc all the way back. At same time work buttonholes as follows: Begin at top of left front. After corner 3 dc work \*2 chains, miss 2 dc, work 9 [10; 11] dcs, repeat from \*, until 4 button-

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holes have been worked. Continue in dc to end.  
Change to orange and work picot-edging as follows: \*Chain 3, 1 dc into 3rd ch from hook, miss 1 dc, 1 slip st into next 2 dc, repeat from \* along fronts and neck.

Sew in buttons corresponding to buttonholes.

Wash gently and leave to dry flat on a towel.
