**ALBA from BC Garn**

**Needles:** 3 and 3.5 mm needles  
(UK Size: 11 and 10/US Size: 2 and 4)

**Tension:** 25 m x 30 p i glat på p nr 3½ = 10 x 10 cm

**Special abbreviations:** selv st = selvedge st, k first and last st on every row.  
3i1 = k1f, k1b, k1f in same st, increase.

**Rib pattern (pattern sequence dividable by 3 + 2 + 2):**

**Row 1:** Selv st, \*P2, K1, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, P2, selv st.

**Row 2:** Work all sts stitchwise, as they appear.

**Row 3:** Selv st, \*P2, 3i1, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, P2, selv st.

**Row 4:** Selv st, \*K2, p3tog, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, K2, selv st.

## **Back:**

Cast on 64 [70; 76; 82] sts using 3 mm needles and col. 09 lime.

Knit 5 rows.

Change to 3.5 mm needles and work rib pattern as above. Continue straight until back measures 17 [19; 21; 24] cm.

Armholes

Cast off 18 [21; 21; 24] sts at beginning of next 2 rows.

Continue straight until back measures 26 [29; 32; 35] cm, last row is pattern row 2.

Change to 3 mm needles.

Knit 5 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Cast off knit-wise (from WS).

## **Front:**

Cast on and work as for back until 13 [16.5; 19; 21.5] cm. Cast off centre 4 [4; 4; 4] sts for placket.

Now work each side separately.

Continue straight until front measures 20.5 [24.5; 27; 30] cm.

Knit 5 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Cast off knitwise (from WS).

## **Sleeves:**

Cast on 52 [55; 58; 61] sts on 3 mm needles and col. 09 lime.

Knit 5 rows.

Change to 3.5 mm needles and work rib pattern as above. Continue straight until sleeve measures 10 [11; 12; 14] cm, last row is pattern row 2.

Change to 3 mm needles.

Knit 5 rows, ending with WS facing for next row.

Cast off knit-wise (from WS).

## **Making up:**

Right hand placket

Cast on 1 st on 3 mm needles, pick up and knit 18 [20; 22; 25] sts along right hand side of placket = 19 [21; 23; 26] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K all sts tbl.

Knit 4 rows.

Cast off knitwise (on WS).

Left hand placket: Using 3 mm needles and col. 09 lime, pick up and knit 18 [20; 22; 25] sts along left hand side of placket, cast on 1 st = 19 [21; 23; 26] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K all sts tbl.

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Next row (buttonhole row): K2 [2; 2; 3], k2tog, yo, K4 [5; 6; 7], k2tog, yo, K3.

Knit 1 row.

Cast off knit-wise on next row (WS).

Sew right hand placket to cast off edge at bottom of placket opening. Then place left hand placket over right hand placket and sew this side in place, still at bottom of placket opening.

Slide sleeves in position on cast off edge at arm-holes. Cast off edge of sleeve is joined to back and front of vest. Sew sleeve sides onto cast off edge of front and back.

Sew in buttons in position corresponding to buttonholes.

## Trousers

Stripe sequence:

Row 1-4: grey

Row 5-6: orange

Row 7-10: grey

Row 11-12: yellow

Repeat these 12 rows for stripe sequence.

Cast on 58 [62; 66; 70] sts on 3 mm needles and col. 09 lime.

Knit 5 rows.

Change to 3.5 mm needles and work stripe sequence as described above.

Row 1: Increase 24 [28; 28; 30] sts evenly along first row = 82 [90; 94; 100] sts.

Continue straight working stripe sequence and st st, ending on row 2 (grey) on second grey stripe (this goes for all sizes). Leave sts to rest on holder and work second leg as first.

## Join legs:

Using 3.5 mm needle and col. 14 grey, cast on 3 sts, knit all sts from first leg, cast on 5 sts, knit all sts from second leg, cast on 3 sts = 175 [191; 199; 211] sts.

Continue in st st and stripe sequence as established. Work 3 rows.

Shaping front and back:

Next row (RS): K2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts before centre 5 sts, sl1 k-wise, K1, pssso, K5, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, sl1 k-wise, K1, pssso, K2.

Work decrease as on last row on every foll 6th row

6 [7; 8; 9] times = 151 [163; 167; 175] sts.

After last decrease work one more non-grey stripe (2 rows) = 14 [16; 18; 20] cm from joint.

Short row shaping:

Continue in col. 14, grey only. Knit 1 row. Turn.

Next row: P40. Turn.

Next row: Sl1 k-wise, k to end.

Next row: P30. Turn.

Next row: Sl1 k-wise, k to end.

Next row: P20. Turn.

Next row: Sl1 k-wise, k to end.

Next row (WS): Purl to end.

Next row: K40. Turn.

Next row: Sl1 p-wise, p to end.

Next row: K30. Turn.

Next row: Sl1 p-wise, p to end.

Next row: K20. Turn.

Next row: Sl1 p-wise, p to end.

Work 2 rows in st st.

## Waistband:

Change to 3 mm needles and col. 18 yellow.

Next row (RS): K to end, **at same time** decrease evenly on row to = 100 (110) 120 (130) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Work 2 rows in st st.

Knit next 2 rows.

Work next 2 rows in st st.

Cast off knit-wise on next row (RS).

## Making up:

Join centre back seam using mattress sts. Join leg seams. Fold waistband to WS and sew in place, leave a small hole open. Drag through elastic on inside waistband and sew ends together. Sew hole.

Weave in all ends. Wash gently and leave to dry flat on a towel.
