SCARF WITH POCKETS

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and M cast on 51 sts.
1st row P3, [k3, p3] to end.
2nd row K3, [p3, k3] to end.
These 2 rows form the rib.
Cont rib until scarf measures 79cm/31in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.
Cut off M.
Join on C.
Cont rib until scarf measures 158cm/62in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.
Cast off in rib.

To complete

Fold first and last 14cm/5 $^{\prime\prime}_{2}$ in to right side and sew side seams to form pockets.





SCARF WITH STRIPES AND POCKETS

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and C cast on 51 sts. **1st row** P3, [k3, p3] to end. **2nd row** K3, [p3, k3] to end. These 2 rows form the rib. Cont rib until scarf measures 6cm/2 ½in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row. Join on M. Work [4 rows M, 8 rows C] twice. Cont in M until scarf measures rib until scarf measures 144cmcm/56 ½in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row. Join on C. Work [8 rows C, 4 rows M] twice. Using C work a further 6cm/2 ½in. Cast off in rib. To complete Fold first and last 14cm/5 ½in to right side and sew side seams to form pockets.

SKILL LEVEL Beginner

MEASUREMENTS Hat: One size Scarf: 15cm/6in wide by 130cm/51in long.

MATERIALS as pictured

Hat:

- One 50g ball of MillaMia Naturally Soft Merino in Fuchsia (143) (M).
- Two balls in Daisy Yellow (141) (C).
- Pair each of 3mm (US 2) and 3.25mm (US 3) needles. Scarf:
- Two 50g balls in each of MillaMia Naturally Soft Merino in Fuchsia (143) (M) and Daisy (141) (C) (except striped version of scarf which uses four balls of M and one ball of C).
- Pair of 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

TENSION / GAUGE

25 sts and 34 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

cont continue; k or K knit; k2 tog knit two stitches together; p or P purl; p2 tog purl two stitches together; rem remain(ing); st(s) stitch(es); st st stocking stitch

PLAIN HAT

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and M, cast on 110 sts. **1st row** P2, [k3, p3] to end. **2nd row** K3, [p3, k3] to last 5 sts, p3, k2. These 2 rows form the rib. Work a further 16 rows. ** Mark each end of last row with a coloured thread. Change to 3mm (US 2) needles. Work a further 17 rows in rib. Cut off M. Join on C. Change to 3.25mm (US 3) needles. Starting with a k row cont in st st until hat measures 15cm/6in from coloured thread, ending with a p row.

Shape top

Row 1 [K10, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 2 P to end. **Row 3** [K9, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 4 P to end. **Row 5** [K8, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 6 P to end. **Row 7** [K7, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 8 P to end. **Row 9** [K6, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 10 P to end. **Row 11** [K5, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 12 P to end. **Row 13** [K4, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 14 P to end. **Row 15** [K3, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 16 P to end. Row 17 [K2, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 18 P to end. **Row 19** [K1, k2 tog] 9 times, k2. Row 20 P to end. Next row [K2 tog] 10 times. Next row [P2 tog] 5 times. Leaving a long end, cut off yarn and thread through rem sts, pull up and secure. Join seam, reversing seam for brim.

POM-POM HAT

Work as Plain Hat to end. Use left over yarn in M to make a pom-pom and attach to top of Hat.

HAT WITH STRIPES

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and M, cast on 110 sts.
1st row P2, [k3, p3] to end.
2nd row K3, [p3, k3] to last 5 sts, p3, k2.
These 2 rows form the rib.
Work a further 4 rows M, [2 rows C, 4 rows M] twice.
Work as Plain Hat from ** to end.
